The battery in Mio is not removable. The replacement of the battery is not allowed and opening or tampering with the device will void the warranty.

⚠ Safety Instructions

- 1.** Install this device in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- 2.** Do not open, modify and/or disassemble the device for any reason.
- 3.** This device is designed for indoor use. Keep the device out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- 4.** Keep this device in a dry environment between -10°C and $+40^{\circ}\text{C}$. Talkido Mio is not drip -or splash- proof. Do not expose the device to excess moisture or immerse it in water.
- 5.** Clean Mio only with a dry cloth. Do not clean with liquids. Do not use solvents, chlorides or chemical cleaning agents. Do not clean Mio when plugged to a charger.
- 6.** Charge the battery regularly to protect battery life. Use only with the charging cable provided by the manufacturer. Charging must be performed by adults.
- 7.** Protect the charging cable from being walked on or pinched. Do not use damaged charging cables to charge the device. Always use with a 5V adapter that is certified by CE or FCC.
- 8.** Do not charge the device during lightning storms.

9. Use only attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
10. Do not place the speaker of the device close to anyone's ear. Exposure to loud sounds may lead to hearing impairment.
11. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel. Servicing is required when the device has been damaged in any way, such as when the charging port is damaged, the device has been dropped, or exposed to moisture or rain.
